ORDER

In exercise of powers conferred by S. O. 1547 (E) dated 28-10-2005 and Corrigendum notified by S.O. 1580 (E) dated 09-11-2005 under Clause 3(5)(A)(1) of Jute and Jute Textiles Control Order 2000, you are hereby directed to furnish your raw jute stock position in the format given below immediately by forenoon of 21-12-2005 so that the Jute Commissioner may specify the maximum or minimum quantity of raw jute which a person/ trader/ dealer/ may have in his possession. **You are also directed to stop making purchase of any raw jute until further orders of the Jute Commissioner which will invariably be given by 23-12-2005 forenoon.**

This order is with reference to Section 3 (5)(A)(2) whereby Jute Commissioner is required to have information regarding the quantities of raw jute, gradewise, in stock, period and purpose for which such stocks of raw jute are being held by manufacturers / stockists as well as genuine and firm commitment to sell and to

deliver before he orders what stock of raw jute a manufacturer or dealer may have and what amount of stock can be delivered under Section 3(5)(A)(1).

4. The above information is being requested for as 15 composite jute mills have not furnished their raw jute stock position for week ending 09-12-2005 and production figures of November 2005 have not been made available by all jute mills as on date. IJMA on being asked about how many weeks of supply of raw jute the mills should hold, have informed on 19-12-2005 that the Committee of IJMA could not take a decision in the matter and stocks of raw jute varies from a range of 2 to 8 weeks and have left the decision to be taken by the Jute Commissioner.
5. Failure to comply with the above order may invite penalty as per Clause 9 of the Jute and Jute Textiles Control Order 2000.
